RC Silves Global Warming Project, we offer a few tips to help you combat global warming.

Try to use cosmetics, scrubs, toothpaste and beauty products that do not contain microbeads because of the marine pollution they are causing. If you're unsure, check the label and avoid products containing polyethylene (PE), polypropylene (PP), polyethylene terephthalate (PET), polymethyl methacrylate (PMMA), polytetrafluoroethylene (PTFE) and nylon.
