

# Support for Casa de Povo





During this pandemic it has become difficult for Casa do Povo to support all the local families that are in need. As we were unable to meet, members have donated their lunch money and more to a relief fund which allows us to cover those little emergencies that this pandemic has forced on the local community in Messines. Our help also lead to local butchers and grocers joining in with meat and vegetables.

#### Masks for Younger Pupils

After the long break following the Covid 19 Pandemic, it became evident in the local schools that younger pupils and the deaf and hard of hearing found it difficult to understand their teachers whilst they are masked. To help alleviate the problem, RC Silves donated masks with transparent sections.



### Casa de Poyo Therapy Rooms

Working closely with Casa de Povo over the last year we have raised funds to help equip their newly built therapy rooms. The rooms are used for the education and support of adults who have mental difficulties. For this service to continue, the government, wanted specific physiological diagnostic tests to be implemented. RC Silves recently donated 1200€ to purchase these much needed resources.

Other schools and support centres have found masks can cause communication difficulties for staff working with young or disadvantaged. This was no different for Casa de Povo. RC Silves was able to donate masks with transparent windows for the Kindergarten Educators, Technicians who teach Music and English classes in pre-school and day care, technicians working with people with mental illness and those working with disadvantaged children.



### Christmas Shoebox Campaign

RC Silves worked with Castelo de Sonhos on the "Christmas Shoebox Campaign for the Elderly" It was again a tremendous success. Over 250 boxes were collected & delivered. The Silves based Castelo de Sonhos charity were able to reach many more elderly folk this year. RC Silves members also purchased slippers during the festive season and gave direct donations enabling sufficient extra food for families in need to ensure a traditional family meal this Christmas.



# Cameras for Online Teaching

During the recent confinements, online teaching has become the norm for students and teachers alike. A new and valuable skill has been learnt. To enable these to be shown at their best, Agrupamento de Escolas Silves Sul needed access to good quality cameras. RC Silves was able to donate two cameras to support the school in delivering online learning at its normal high standard.

Goodwill and
fellowship between

This rotary year 2020/21, RC Silves has joined the new Inter-Country Committee established between Portugal - Great Britain-Ireland (RGB&I).

The clubs involved have committed to increase international understanding, intercultural sharing, establish goodwill and promote fellowship between Britain, Ireland and Portugal. Through common projects they will aim to improve awareness and mutual understanding between communities and cultures.

#### Back to School

The "Back to School" campaign is is coordinated by Castelo de Sonhos and supported by RC Silves and other charities. It aims to provide under privileged students with the necessary backpack and stationery to start school in September. This year trainers and socks for PE have been added to the list. Working with other charities RC Silves donated school materials and cash which should allow Castelo de Sonhos to purchase all the remaining materials needed for the kids on its register.



APEXA (Association for the Support of the Exceptional Person of the Algarve), aims to provide a Community Rehabilitation Centre with neuro equipment -sensory, of Electro stimulation equipment and Therapeutic material This project will allow APEXA to respond to the people with disabilities, in high or very high need for rehabilitative services, It will serve 8 of the 16 municipalities in the Algarve, RC Silves has donated 500€ in support of this project lead by RC Albufeira and supported by other Rotary Clubs in the Algarve.

### End Polio Now

We donated 1100€ to the end polio now campaign from monies collected for sales of the The Resident and donations. The money will be used to purchase Covid vaccines for those in need.
